Our speaker this month is Scott Barker.



Scott Grant Barker is co-author of *Intimate Modernism: Fort Worth Circle Artists in the 1940s*, published in 2008 by the Amon Carter Museum. Since 2000, he has also written art-related essays for publication by the Texas State Historical Association, the *Langdon Review of the Arts in Texas*, the Texas Historical Foundation, Texas Christian University Press, and the Fort

Worth Star-Telegram. Barker is a native Texan and cultural historian specializing in the art history of Fort Worth. The Fort Worth Circle and their place in the art history of the Lone Star State has been a focus of his research since 1992. He has shared his knowledge through numerous exhibitions, including:

- *First Light: Local Art and the Fort Worth Public Library, 1901-1961* (2001)
- *Working at the Limits: Mid-20th Century Texas Sculpture by Gene Owens, Ed Storms and Charles T. Williams* (2006)
- *Sallie Mummert and Her Students, 1925-1945* (2006)
- *Across a Crowded Room: Observations by Ann Ekstrom & Nancy Lamb* (2008)
- Remembering Josephine Mahaffey: *The Texas Dynamo* (2010)
- *Looking for the Lone Star: Early Texas Art from Private Fort Worth Collections* (2011)

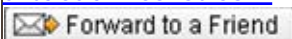
