Free Local Revolving VAST Exhibitions:

Exhibitions have traditionally been in Denton area businesses/community buildings that permit the safe exhibition of members' art works. Past locations have included Emily Fowler Central Library, Denton, the Denton Senior Center, and cooperating businesses. Members are responsible for insurance on their own work and for hanging or placing it following the direction of the manager or owner of the space. The length of time of the exhibit is dependent upon the location's desires. Please contact the **VAST President** to place your name on the waiting list.

Members receive a wallet card to print out that identifies your current VAST membership for **Asel Art Supply** (20% discount, Dallas locations) and **Voertman's** – (20% discount, Denton location by UNT)

FREE "VADO" - "VISUAL ARTISTS DAY OUT!":

VAST members meet **every Thursday** from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. at the Patterson-Appleton Arts Center classroom for a non-instructed session. Artists create in their media of choice in company with other artists - laughs, comments, stories, art help, and lunch break (at nearby restaurants) if you want are included! If you are interested, please email **Fran Shurtleff** at **VADO@VASTArts.org** and ask to be added to her VADO reminder email list for a gentle weekly reminder (sometimes the PAAC's classroom may be unavailable).

VAST Sponsored Artist Workshops:

VAST holds workshops (in person and/or virtually) throughout the year. Members' **suggestions for workshops are welcomed by the Vice President Programming (VASTArtsVPPPrograms@VASTArts.org)**. VASTWorkshops are **offered to MEMBERS first**, and then to the public. Members workshop fees are **discounted**. Watch for announcements about workshops in the e-newsletter VISION, on VAST's website, and social media.

Critique Group for Members: VAST sponsors a critique group for 12 artists with the goal of providing participants opportunity for professional development. Critiques are personalized and designed to help an artist working at **any level**. Participants bring two pieces of art in **any media** for critique.

VAST chooses the Critique Presenter, who is either a professional artist/art educator/private art teacher with professional experience. Critiques are to be informative and educational. Participants benefit not only from their own critique, but from the critiques of other's artwork as well. For those **new** to the idea of critique, the **first session can be free as an observer only**.

Critique meets monthly, September – May (omitting December). The fee is \$120 payable to VAST in two installments due in September and January. VAST Members can also be included on a **substitute list**. When space is available, substitutes pay VAST \$15 per session. Please email **Critique@VASTArts.org** with questions or for more information.

Free Artist Supply Exchange:

At monthly meetings there will be a designated area for artists to bring supplies, tools, books – anything 'art related' - that the artist would like to pass along. Everyone is invited to give/take as desired. Anything left over will be kept for the next month, given away, or tossed if no one can use the materials.

- Meeting and making friends with Denton area artists
- Learning new artistic material
- Learn by doing - help VAST hang its exhibits, volunteer to provide exhibit assistance on intake and pick-up days, volunteer computer skills to assist in tracking entries and payments for exhibits; there is a whole world of “behind the scenes work” in every art organization, program, museum!

VAST SPONSORED EXHIBITS

VAST's Juried Calendar Competition:

VAST produces an annual desk calendar featuring juried work by our members as its **only fundraiser**. Entries of calendar art are limited to VAST Members only. Beginning March 1, watch for the Calendar “prospectus” on our website and social media; entry to the juried competition is free if your membership is renewed before May 31! The Desk Calendars, popular holiday gifts, and can be purchased at the VAST in-person meetings **early in the fall**.

Members Exhibition:

VAST sponsors this **annual event** to offer its members (only!) an opportunity to enter their work in a juried exhibition that showcases **VAST artwork**. The exhibit provides an excellent venue for the North Texas community to appreciate the high quality and diverse nature of art produced by area VAST artists. Watch the newsletter and website for information on the date/location/deadline-for-entry. The prospectus will also be emailed to members in a timely manner. The 2022 Members Exhibition will open on Saturday November 26, 2022. Look for the prospectus in September 2022.

175-Mile Visual Arts Exhibition:

This regional juried exhibition is open to **all artists** (VAST members and non-members) of visual media (2D and 3D) who reside within a 175 mile radius of Denton. Members' entries receive a **discount** on the entry fee. Watch the newsletter and website for information. The prospectus will be emailed to members in a timely manner. Information to the general public is shared through social media, flyers, emails, and to local news outlets. The 2022 175-Mile Visual Arts Exhibition will open Friday January 6, 2022. Look for the prospectus in November 2022.

FREE Monthly VAST Meetings' Mini-Shows and Artist of the Month/Year

Competition: VAST members are encouraged to bring ONE piece of their art to the monthly meetings for a member's choice competition. The first place winner, chosen by members present voting, will be the VAST Artist of the Month.

The Artist of the Month will receive a \$25 Azel Art gift certificate and automatically be entered in May's Artist of the Year competition. We ask Artists of the Month to refrain from entering the remaining Mini-shows as a competitor, but they are welcome to enter additional artworks for comments or critiques.

The Mini-show will not be held during April (High School Competition time) or May (when members will choose among the Artists of the Month for the VAST Artist of the Year)

FREE - Monthly Members' Meetings presents "A NEW Show in Town for 2022-23 VAST Year" - CREATIVE STRETCH:

CREATIVE STRETCH Details: Each month a **separate competition** will be held that has a theme. This year we'll be creatively exploring the following:

September 2022:	Photography
October 2022:	Fall Themed Artwork
November 2022:	Box Challenge*
December 2022:	Tiny Pieces (6"x6" pieces or smaller)
January 2023:	Trash to Treasure - reused products only
February 2023:	Mardi Gras Themed Artwork
March 2023:	Spring Fling Florals Theme
April 2023:	(High School Student show only)
May 2023:	3D Art (ceramics, textiles, sculpture)

*For the Box Challenge, in October, a limited number of boxes with identical supplies inside and specific 'rules' to follow will be distributed to first-come-first-served interested artists. The November show will highlight those artists' interpretation, construction from the materials, while following the 'rules'.

Creative Stretch winners will receive \$15 Azel Art gift certificate. Artists are welcome to enter their Creative Stretch pieces in a mini-show in a different month.
